Α:	First try to contact a Club Official. Dial 919-776-2003 (the Club number), choose Option 9, and this will automatically ring the Club officers, the Chief Flight Instructor, and the Director of Maintenance.
В:	Call your flight instructor. Also post a report on the "General" channel of the Wings of Carolina Slack workspace. Be careful to include your name and phone number for a return call by a Club officer.
C :	First call the Club number (919.776.2003) and select Option 2, which will ring the Flight Center. Leave a message and wait for a return call from a Club officer
D:	Call the Club number (919.776.2003) and continue to call until someone answers the call.
Ε:	Send an email to "accident@wingsofcarolina.org" and state briefly the "who, why, what, and where" of the accident and your name and phone number for a response from a Club official.
